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

MANUFACTURING OF TOUGHENED GLASS




MFG Steps

- 1) Shell Manufacturing
- 2) Cap & Pin Assembly



SHELL FORMING



Automated Shell Forming Process


SHELL MARKINGS

- Test value
- M&E rating
- Product ID
- Cavity #
- Date code
- Factory ID



TOUGHENING PROCESS

- Homogenization Furnace
- Rapid Compressed Air Cooling
- Transfer to Thermal Cycle



THERMAL CYCLE

Stage 1

- Positive Thermal Shock – Increase temperature 300°C
- Negative Thermal Shock – Air Cooled

Stage 2

- Positive Thermal Shock – Increase temperature
- Negative Thermal Shock – Water Cooled



SHELL MANUFACTURING COMPLETE



CAP & PIN ASSEMBLY

CAP

- Ductile Iron socket fitting, galvanized
- Product Markings



PIN

- Forged steel, galvanized
- Zinc sleeve
- Bituminous tar coating

- Alumina Cement
- Hot Cure Cycle

TESTING

Routine Testing


- 100% on all insulators
- Electrical – continuous flash-over for 4 minutes.
- Mechanical – held at 50% of SML rating for 1 minute

Validation & Test Reports

- Design tests per standards
- Customer required tests
- Design testing must take into account both location of shell manufacturing and assembly location.

Sample Testing

- By Lot
- Visual & dimensional test.
- Galvanizing test
- Puncture Test (Impulse Test).
- Locking system validation
- M&E Test
